The ENACTED project partnership continues to work on refining the Enacted Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform.

The ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform was developed with the aim of supporting formal and non-formal educators for the acquisition of inclusive teaching strategies dedicated to migrant students' integration.

What are the news about the platform?

The ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform contains a catalogue of innovative practices in the field of inclusive education. These practices already implemented in partner countries by teachers and non-formal educators are registered in the **Depository of** Innovative Practices for Inclusive Education (DIPIE) and can be download for free. The DIPIE template contains a brief description of the best practice implemented and a contact reference of the person or organization that applies or has applied a specific practice in the field of inclusive education. Thus, you will have the opportunity not only to learn about innovative practices for inclusive education, but also to get in contact with schools or non-formal organizations that are actively engage in the field of inclusive education.

On the other hand, the peer learning and mentoring section of the platform is dedicated to the informal discussion and exchange between formal and non-formal educators. Thanks to the intervention of some selected mentors, the platform users will be able to contribute to fruitful

discussions in three thematic working groups identified by the partnership:

- practices focused directly on NAMS' facilitation in educational integration;
- practices that focus on training and empowering TEACHERS;
- practices concentrated on encouraging PARENTAL involvement for NAMS' better accommodation in school process.

In this context, mentors will be crucial to activate and to moderate the discussions within the thematic groups.

How can you participate?

What is coming up next?

In the next months we plan to organize a series of round tables on the innovative education practices identified to reflecting and exchanging views on how to scale them up in different contexts and levels. One physical round table will be implemented in each participating country and two virtual roundtables at a transnational level. Those roundtables bringing together schools, CSOs, and policymakers will facilitate the promotion of common values on inclusive education, resulting in a Charter of Common Values for Education and Diversity.

Furthermore, the partnership will provide a number of capacity building sessions organized by non-formal educators for primary and secondary school teachers. During the capacity building sessions educators from civil society organizations platform's present the innovative functionalities to formal education providers and they will show how to further adapt and adopt the innovative practices of inclusive education.
